START

1. Positions on the START line:
 - 1.1. First day start line will be set by following principles
 - 1.2. EXTREME CLASS - according to test drive result. Fastest pilot chooses start position first and accordingly selection follows.
 - 1.3. CROSSOVER + SIDE BY SIDE - class starts by registration number sequence. Who registered and payed all fees first chooses start position first and accordingly selection follows.
 - 1.4. ADVENTURE - class starts by registration number sequence. Who registered and payed all fees first chooses start position first and accordingly selection follows.
 - 1.5. All following days start position will depend from overall result, fastest racers choosing first.
2. Start announcement procedure:
 - Starting time will be announced in every morning at briefing
 - All participants will be reminded about start time 15 and 5 minutes before, at starting area
 - All participants will be reminded once again about start time 1 minute before, at starting area.
 - After signal of 1min and showing RED FLAG - ALL ENGINES MUST BE SWITCHED OFF. PIC #1
 - After “15 seconds sign” is shown, start can be given in any moment after that.
 - START will be given with GREEN FLAG, moving from top to bottom at a 90 degree angle.
3. All racers must leave start area during 15 minutes after START is given.
4. If racer is not leaving START area within 15 minutes, he will get Yellow flag for the race day.

FINISH

1. At participant registration moment, participant will be provided with 2 (two) bracelets with RFID TAG.
 - 1.1. Every bracelet has same number as participants start number.
 - 1.2. Racer have right put RFID TAG in any place by his choice
 - 1.3. It is recommended to put bracelets on different hands.
 - 1.4. RFID bracelet has no battery. The principle of operation is based on radio waves



2. When participant reaches finish zone he must:
 - 2.1. Touch one of 5 RFID antennas with his bracelet
 - 2.2. When RFID antenna reads bracelet, racer will hear sound signal and red light will flash on RFID antenna.
 - 2.3. After completing this action, participant must move away from RFID antenna IMMEDIATELY, and don't obstruct possibility for other participants to perform scanning process.
 - 2.4. Participant must move away his vehicle from finish zone as soon as possible
 - 2.5. If for any reasons RFID antenna will not emit sound and red flashing lite, participant must rise his hand immediately. Judges will mark arrival time.
 - 2.6. GPS devices must be returned to finish judge not later than 3 minutes after RFID scan time.
3. Finish zone will be under video surveillance.
