APPENDIX #4

1. Driver or team mechanic must deliver to inspection a technically neat vehicle in accordance with the class requirements.
2. During technical inspection, following things will be checked:
 - 2.1. Brake system (for normal function)
 - 2.2. Exhaust sound level will be checked with dB meter, limit – not more the OEM level - 96dB 2 meter radius
 - 2.3. Correct placement of stickers as the rules require (page 4)
 - 2.4. HELMET, GOGGLES, and BOOTS only for Crossover and Extreme class. (Page 5)
 - 2.5. Chassis system (for normal function)
3. Driver holds all responsibility for the technical condition of his vehicle.
4. During the event, Chief Judge of the Technical Commission can check and inspect any vehicle.
5. It is forbidden to change vehicle during the event, or pass vehicle to other driver.
6. If noise level will be more than on the OEM exhaust specs, racer will not be allowed to start.
7. Only if the exhaust is changed and re-checked with dB meter, pilot is allowed to start.
8. Rear STOP signal. Can be third party manufacturer stopping signal.

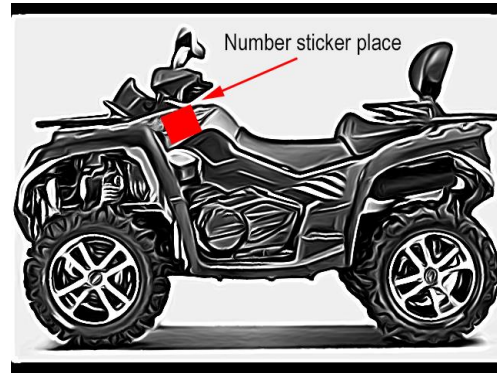
